The Birthday Bash parking lot party Friday night will be open to all Meet Registrants and is included in the meet registration fee.

The dinner buffet will be set up Cafeteria style with the option of purchasing plate specials or a la carte items at very reasonable prices. There will be a cash bar and dancing to the music of a band by pool side.

Saturday night the Meet will end with the Awards Ceremony. This will be a very special part of the festivities. As the awards are presented, you will be able to see on a large screen slides of the winning cars. This promises to be a very special Awards Ceremony to be enjoyed by all. If you have never stayed for this event before, I urge you to consider attending this Grand Finale celebrating the commitment that we all have made to the preservation of the premier muscle car of our time. 
