

Every year, Gateway GTO takes part in two big charity car shows in September. The first is the Wheels In Motion - Old Cars Against Cancer show that we put on with First Capital Classics. This fall was no different as we participated in the 29th such show.

What was different for this year is that we were at the new location that Earl had found for the event, the Church on the Rock in St. Peters. We had already had one show at the church in May that went really well, especially as compared to some of the Wheels In Motion events where the locations were less than ideal. In contrast, the Church on the Rock is a perfect location for a car show. It has a huge parking lot for the show itself and adjacent large parking lots for spectators. In addition, the Church on the Rock is an excellent partner for the event. They have embraced the show fully and were a major factor in the success of both shows. Tommy Prater, whose day job is managing finances for the church has been nothing short of amazing in his support and enthusiasm for the show. With his help, the shows in both the spring and the fall were excellent.

For the fall show we set up and ran our traditional Gateway GTO raffle as a fund raiser. As usual, Gateway members stepped up and gathered lots of great prizes like gift baskets and restaurant gift certificates. Gateway also kicked in a TV and two kids bikes.


